They offer laser eye treatments that help correct a person's eyesight permanently, so that patients no longer have to rely on glasses or contact lenses to enhance their vision.

Statistics show that approximately 90% of the people who undergo laser surgery gain 20/20 or 20/40 vision. This indicates the success ratio of laser eye treatment clinics. 20/20 vision is the optimal state of human distance vision. It indicates that the patient can see things on an eye chart at a distance of 20 feet in the same detail as normal person would, whereas 20/40 vision is half that acuity. It is important to point out that the restoration of clear vision is associated with common side effects, such as unclear or blurred vision, dry eyes, itchiness near the eye or simply a dull burning sensation. It normally takes two to three months before the eye

completely heals and the effects disappear.

Laser eye surgery can sometimes result in complications. If dust particles are trapped within the cornea during surgery, it could bulge out, resulting in an infection, inflammation of the eye, loss of vision or irreversible blindness. One must thus be careful when choosing a clinic for eye treatment and shouldn't just select one that's cheap or close to home. The clinic should preferably be one that you can trust with high rates of success and strong reputation for professional work. Here are a few guidelines you must consider when selecting a clinic:

- Ask your doctor to recommend a few qualified clinics
- Search for renowned laser eye treatment clinics in your region on the internet
- Ask any people you know who have had the treatment done and from where, and whether they were satisfied with the service provided by the respective clinic. If you aren't familiar with any such people, ask them to introduce you to anyone they know who have gone through with the procedure.
- Choose a clinic with surgeons who are updated with the

latest research, information and technology on laser eye surgery.

- Find out the surgeons credentials and qualifications, origin of training and doctorate, experience with previous patients and any associated complaints of these patients.
- Set up appointments with the shortlisted clinics. This will allow you to go in and talk to the surgeons, evaluate the standards of the clinics, get answers for any questions you might have and most of all see whether you feel comfortable with the facilities and personnel. You should also become aware of lawsuits, incidents or malpractices associated with the clinic in the past.
